- AVAILABLE — W. T. "Billy" Tolar (Hwy 378, Sumter Hwy) / Wateree River
- Friends of Congaree Swamp — Bates Bridge (Hwy 601) & surrounding area

Saluda River—Riverbanks Zoo Area
